Position Summary:

Working within a multi-disciplinary team framework throughout Oxford County, the Clinician will provide crisis & outreach support to individuals who contact or are referred to Program and Counseling support and to those attending CMHA Oxford's Walk-In Counselling Services. The clinician will also support individuals while working with WPS and OPP as a member of the Mental Health Engagement and Response Team.

- Currently registered or in the process of registering with the Ontario College of Social Workers and Social Service Workers, the College of Nurses of Ontario, or the College of Occupational Therapists of Ontario is required, as per the Collective Agreement

- Ability to develop short-term treatment plans in conjunction with the individual
- Ability to advocate for and coordinate service access with clients
